- (4) Copies (1 each) of five representative publications (Offprints and duplicates acceptable.)
- (5) A summary of research achievements and a statement of a research agenda (Maximum two A4 pages)
- (6) A statement of the applicant's view on, and ambition for, teacher education. (Maximum two A4 pages)

Submission Due Date: Applications must be received by November 30, 2009.

- (1) Selection process will be based on TGU's faculty selection criteria.
- (2) Interviews may be required if appropriate.
