#### **About ICTE 2021**

The ICTE 2021 will be held on 26th to 29th January 2021 at the National Taiwan Normal University. ICTE 2021 encompasses a 3-day programme expecting participants mainly from Japan, New Zealand, Korea, Taiwan, Australia, Hong Kong, China, Singapore, the USA, but other countries or areas are also welcome. All papers are restricted to a maximum length of 3,000 words, excluding author(s) data, abstract and references. Full papers will undergo a peer review process. Authors are expected to present their papers at the Conference.

- 2. Name(s) of the author(s),
- 3. Affiliation(s) of the author(s),
- 4. Address(es) of the author(s),
- 5. E-mail address(es) of the author(s), and
- 6. Abstract and full paper.
