Over the past 25 years, the conference has provided lots of chances for academicians and Technology Educational professionals to interact with members inside and outside their own particular disciplines.

About ICTE 2021

The ICTE 2021 will be held on 26th to 27th January 2021 at the National Taiwan Normal University. ICTE 2021 encompasses a 3-day programme expecting participants mainly from Japan, New Zealand, Korea, Taiwan, Australia, Hong Kong, China, Singapore, the USA, but other countries or areas are also welcome. During the main conference, scholarly exchange will take a variety of forms including keynote speech and invited speaker addresses, paper presentations, and panel discussions. It would be a valuable opportunity bringing together scholars and professionals sharing ideas and experience.

All papers are restricted to a maximum length of ten pages, printed in single space. Full papers will undergo a peer review process. Authors are expected to present their papers at the Conference. Please include the following six items with your paper submission:

1. Title of the submission, 2. Name(s) of the author(s),

3. Affiliation(s) of the author(s), 4. Address(es) of the author(s), 5. E-mail address(es) of the author(s), and 6. Abstract and full paper.
